

# Regulations on Evaluations for NPUST University-Funded Research Fellows

Ratified by the 238 Administrative Meeting, on May 16, 2019

Ratified by the 246 Administrative Meeting, on April 16, 2020

## Article 1

In order to continuously enhance the research performance of University-Funded Research Fellows, academic funding is being injected by the university and various research indicators have been established. Accordingly, based on Article 6 of the “Regulations for Hiring University-Funded Research Fellows”, the “Regulations on Evaluations for NPUST University-Funded Research Fellows” have been established (hereafter, “Regulations”).

## Article 2

Two (2) months prior to the end of the contract term, University-Funded Research Fellows shall take action to apply for an evaluation of the research, services, and education they are providing. The evaluation will serve as reference for contract extension.

Prior to the arrival of the evaluation period, if it has already been confirmed that the contract for the University-Funded Research Fellow will not be extended, the evaluation shall be exempted.

## Article 3

Each year, NPUST University-Funded Research Fellows shall be subjected to evaluations regarding research, services and education.

The items of evaluation are listed in the attached “Evaluation Standards”.

## Article 4

The University-Funded Research Fellow Evaluation Committee (hereafter, “Committee”) shall be comprised of members appointed by the President of NPUST; the Committee shall be chaired by the NPUST Vice-President for Academic Affairs.

### **Evaluation Procedures:**

- 1) Self-Evaluation: Research Fellows are to conduct self-evaluations of the actual situations according to the evaluation items and related subject

matter. They are to provide supporting evidences to the related overseeing offices which will conduct the verification and preliminary evaluation.

- 2) Preliminary-Evaluation: Once the General Research Service Center has conducted the preliminary review of the “self-evaluation” and approved it, the evaluation shall be sent to the Committee for deliberations.
- 3) Re-evaluation: The Committee shall conduct deliberations on the evaluation which has been submitted and make a decision regarding its approval and the extension of the contract. If necessary, based on stated reasons, the results of the preliminary evaluation may be revised or sent back for reconsideration. The Committee shall base their decision about contract renewal on the task requirements, funding status, and evaluated performance, and execute the renewal of the contract upon receiving signed approval from the President of NPUST.

One month prior to the end of the original contract period, the Human Resources Office and the Research Fellow under review shall both be notified of the results of the review and the Committee’s decision in order to complete the procedures related to the extension or termination of the contract.

## **Article 5**

If the evaluation results are not approved and the Committee decides not to extend the contract, at the end of the contract term, the appointment shall be discontinued.

## **Article 6**

These regulations and any amendments are to be executed upon ratification by the General Research Service Center Steering Committee and Executive Council.

Note:

1. Items that have already been tallied should not be repeated. Only when a single item has multiple instances of performance may it be listed separately.

2. The execution of university-wide projects, government agency projects or industry-academia cooperation projects shall be determined according to the designations of principal investigator, co-principal investigator or sub-investigator/research fellow. The number of cases and budgets shall be calculated accordingly:

(1) Number of Cases

Principal Investigator= 1 case x 100%; Co-Principal Investigator= 1 case x 50% ÷ number of co-principal investigator; Sub-Investigator/Research Fellow= 1 case x 30% ÷ number of sub-investigators/research fellows.

(2) Funds

Principal Investigator= Total funds x 100%; Co-Principal Investigator= Total funds x 50% ÷ number of co-principal investigator;  
Sub-Investigator/Research Fellow = Total funds x 30% ÷ number of sub-investigators/research fellows.

3. Verification of industry-academia cooperation projects shall be done according to the “NPUST Regulations for Handling Commissioned Research Projects”. Project final reports or related meeting materials will not be given consideration.
4. Indexed journal papers shall be determined based on the time of the letter of acceptance for periodic publication **or** the names list of publications in Science, Nature, SSCI, AHCI, SCIE or Ministry of Science and Technology Social Science Citation Index (TSSCI) journals or Taiwan Humanities Citation Index (THCI) journals at the time of publication. If there are any disputes, it shall be based on the names lists published in the Library and Exhibition Hall. Item A2-1 may also include those accepted by Engineering Index (EI) or Scopus journals.
5. Patents or technology transfers must be registered in the name of the university to be given consideration
